SEEKS CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (CJA) PANEL ATTORNEY APPLICATIONS

Attorneys are being sought to serve on the Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Panel for the Middle District of Pennsylvania. The CJA Panel consists of private attorneys who are eligible and willing to be appointed to provide representation to indigent criminal defendants under the Criminal Justice Act. The court has established a separate panel of attorneys for Harrisburg, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, and Williamsport vicinages. Ten attorneys in Harrisburg, nine attorneys in Scranton/Wilkes-Barre vicinage and five attorneys in the Williamsport vicinage are needed to serve as panel members. Attorneys admitted to membership on the CJA Panel will serve for a term of three years beginning June 1, 2010. Interested attorneys can apply by completing the Membership Application for the Criminal Justice Act Panel for the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania. This application can be found on our website at <http://pam.fd.org>. Applications are due by March 31, 2010.
