In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28 United States Code, Section 631 et seq., the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, the January 4, 2006 Report of the Merit Selection Panel appointed pursuant to Chapter III, Section 3.01 of the Regulations for the Appointment of United States Magistrate Judges, and the unanimous vote of all judges of the appointing court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


The Honorable J. Andrew Smyser be and is hereby reappointed full-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary and with official station as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at **12:01 EST on June 16, 2006**, but prior to the performance of such duties shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28 United States Code, Section 453 and 631(g).

Said United States Magistrate Judge is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight (8) years from the effective date of his appointment, subject to the provisions of Title 28 United States Code, Sections 631(c) and (f).

The Clerk of Court shall cause copies of this Order to be spread upon the records of the court, and shall likewise forward a copy of this order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Court, as required by 28 United States Code, Section 631(h).
