**ORDER**

**THE BACKGROUND OF THIS ORDER IS AS FOLLOWS:**

On October 24, 2008, the court adopted the Court-Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program, which is a voluntary re-entry program for offenders designed to facilitate the participant's reintegration into the community and maximize the participant's potential for success during the period of supervised release and beyond. Such program will be implemented in March 2009.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**, the Federal Public Defender for the Middle District of Pennsylvania is appointed as counsel of record to represent all offenders authorized by the court as participants in the Court Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program. Such appointment shall be for all re-entry court proceedings.
