

**ORDER**

In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28 U.S.C., Section 631, et seq., and the requirements of the applicable statute and the Judicial Conference of the United States regarding the appointment of United States Magistrate Judges having been satisfied,

IT IS ORDERED that Martin C. Carlson be and he is hereby appointed to serve as full-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary and with the official duty station in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter on duty immediately following taking the oath of office on Saturday, August 15, 2009, as prescribed by Title 28 U.S.C., Sections 453 and 631(g).

The said full-time United States Magistrate Judge is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for the term of eight (8) years from the effective date of his appointment subject to the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C., Section 631(i).

The Clerk of Court will cause notice and copies of this order to be spread upon the records of this court, and shall likewise forward a copy of this order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as required by Title 28 U.S.C., Section 631(h).
