

**ORDER**

**THE BACKGROUND OF THIS ORDER IS AS FOLLOWS:**

On October 24, 2008, the court adopted the Court-Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program. C.A.R.E is a voluntary re-entry program for offenders designed to facilitate the participant's reintegration into the community and maximize the participant's potential for success during the period of supervised release and beyond. This program has already been implemented in Harrisburg and Scranton. It will be implemented in Williamsport beginning in August 2010.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**, Magistrate Judge William Arbuckle is appointed as presiding judge for the Williamsport Court Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program. Such appointment shall be for all re-entry court proceedings.
