**AUTHORIZING A PACER FEE WAIVER
FOR NON-PROFIT EDUCATIONAL
RESEARCH**

STANDING ORDER

WHEREAS Morgan L. W. Hazelton, fourth-year graduate student at Washington University in St. Louis, has requested a PACER fee exemption to engage in academic research for a dissertation on how changes in law influence litigant behavior; and

WHEREAS, Morgan L. W. Hazelton has demonstrated to the court's satisfaction that a fee exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT a fee-exempt PACER ID and password be issued to Morgan L. W. Hazelton to conduct academic research at the aforementioned University for the period commencing December 1, 2011 and ending November 30, 2012;

IT IS ALSO ORDERED THAT Morgan L. W. Hazelton is granted an exemption under the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule for any and all available documents relating to the aforementioned research;

IT IS ALSO ORDERED THAT Morgan L. W. Hazelton is prohibited from selling for profit any data obtained as a result of this Order.
