WHEREAS Magistrate Judge Thomas M. Blewitt retired from federal judicial service on January 2, 2015, creating a vacancy for a full-time United States Magistrate Judge in Scranton, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS the Board of Judges of the Middle District of Pennsylvania has determined that the transfer of Magistrate Judge Karoline Mehalchick from Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania to an official duty station in Scranton, Pennsylvania is in the interests of justice; and

WHEREAS the Third Circuit Judicial Council has approved the transfer of Magistrate Judge Mehalchick to Scranton,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the official duty station and chambers of Magistrate Judge Karoline Mehalchick are transferred to the William J. Nealon Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, 235 North Washington Avenue, P.O. Box 443, Scranton, Pennsylvania 18501-0443, effective January 29, 2015.
