**NOTICE OF NEW TRANSCRIPT DELIVERY CATEGORY**

At its March 2018 session, the Judicial Conference approved a new 3-day transcript delivery category, defined as “a transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order,” with rates of \$5.45 per page for original transcript, \$1.05 per first copy page, and \$0.75 per additional copy page to the same party.

Additionally, the Judicial Conference approved language clarifying the definitions of daily, hourly, and real time transcripts. The new language removes references to “adjournment” and “unusual circumstances,” for tolling delivery time. Now, the definitions for all transcript categories and rates are applicable based on when a transcript is ordered from the court reporter, not when the underlying proceeding ended.

## MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES

	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Additional Copy to the Same Party
<b>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.65	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.25	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.85	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.45	\$1.05	\$ .75
<b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page.		

<sup>1</sup>A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
