**ORDER REAPPOINTING PART-TIME
UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28 United States Code, Section 631 et seq.; the requirements of the applicable statute and the Judicial Conference of the United States; the March 25, 2016, Report of the Merit Selection Panel appointed pursuant to Volume III, Chapter 4 of the Guide to Judiciary Policy, Selection, Appointment and Reappointment of Magistrate Judges; and a majority vote of all active judges of this appointing court, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

The Honorable William I. Arbuckle, III, be and is hereby reappointed part-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary and with official station as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at **12:01 a.m. EST** on July 29, 2016, but prior to the performance of such duties shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28 United States Code, Section 453 and 631 (g).

The said part-time United States Magistrate Judge is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of four (4) years from the effective date of his appointment, subject to the provisions of Title 28 United States Code, Sections 631 (c) and (f).

The Clerk of Court shall cause copies of this Order to be spread upon the records of the court, and shall likewise forward a copy of this order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Court, as required by 28 United States Code, Section 631(h).
