ORDER


WHEREAS, on March 3, 2003 the court established by Standing Order No. 03-1 an Electronic Case Filing System and adopted Electronic Case Filing Policies and Procedures to govern the program; and

WHEREAS, Standing Order No. 03-1 requires attorneys who did not register as electronic filing users by September 3, 2003 to show cause why they should be permitted to file in the traditional manner; and

WHEREAS, a review of the court's docket has revealed numerous instances of noncompliance with electronic filing registration requirements;

NOW, THIS 4th DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Within fourteen days of the date of this order, counsel of record in cases now pending in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania shall register as filing users for the court's Electronic Case Filing System and file documents electronically or show cause to the Chief Judge why they should not be required to register as filing users and file documents electronically.
