CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 14

Pursuant to this Court's Case Management Order No. 4 [Dkt. # 60], the

parties conferred and submitted a Revised Joint Proposed Case Management Order

outlining certain case-specific and generic discovery and other goals for the next

120-day period.

The Court hereby adopts this proposal as an Order of the Court as follows:

- 1. Continue ongoing discovery and begin new discovery of an additional hospital (specified among counsel) (approximately 5-7 depositions per hospital along with document subpoenas where needed)
- 2. Continue to implement a process to eliminate and dismiss nonmeritorious cases based upon significant deficiencies in fact sheets.

The parties and Court recognize that this 120-day period is aspirational in nature, with the specified tasks and proposed discovery representing what the parties will work on during this time. The Court has established monthly status calls to keep abreast of progress. Following the 120-day period, the parties and Court will evaluate progress and will seek to establish fact discovery and other case deadlines as appropriate for the status of the case at that time.
