RECALL


The Honorable Gerald B. Cohn, having consented to serve and the chief judge of the district involved having consented to such service, is **RECALLED** for service as a United States Magistrate Judge assigned to the District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania. Judge Cohn will serve at Scranton from his home in Illinois. The magistrate judge is authorized to perform the powers and duties of the office of magistrate judge as provided by the district court.

The appointment is effective on October 1, 2018, and shall continue in effect until and including October 1, 2019. The recall is pursuant to the Ad Hoc Recall Regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference under 28 U.S.C. § 636(h), and the service shall be when-actually-employed, not to exceed a total of 250 days during the entire recall period.

The Judicial Council certifies that the recalled judge will perform the service required by § 1120.40 of the Judicial Conference regulations governing the recall of retired magistrate judges and that the following number and types of staff are appropriate for the recalled magistrate judge's projected and actual workload: one full-time judicial law clerk. The Judicial Council further certifies that substantial service is expected to be performed by Judge Cohn.
