AND NOW, this 30th day of January 2019, as a result of the enactment of the Continuing Resolution funding the operations of the United States Department of Justice, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The December 27, 2018, stay of all civil actions pending in this Court in which the United States or an agency or an officer thereof is a party, and in which the United States is represented by the United States Department of Justice or the United States Attorney for the Middle District of Pennsylvania is LIFTED.
2. All deadlines the December 27, 2018, Order held in abeyance are deemed to be extended by 34 days, the number of days the stay was in effect.
3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to post a copy of this Order on the Court's website, disseminate this Order to all registered CM/ECF users in this District, and transmit a copy to each judicial officer of this District, and to each other judicial officer assigned to any civil cases on this Court's docket.
4. In every case stayed by the December 27, 2018, Order, the United States Attorney shall promptly serve this Order upon the opposing party if

such opposing party is not a CM/ECF user or not represented by a CM/ECF user.

5. This Order may be modified or vacated, as to any particular civil action by order of the presiding judicial officer. Furthermore, a party to a civil action falling within the scope of this Order may for good cause file a motion to extend the deadlines set in this Order.
