The Honorable Gerald B. Cohn, having consented to serve and the chief judge of the district involved having consented to such service, is **RECALLED** for service as a United States Magistrate Judge assigned to the District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania beginning May 1, 2014. Judge Cohn will serve at Scranton from his home in Illinois. The magistrate judge is authorized to perform the powers and duties of the office of magistrate judge as provided by the district court.
