


UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE THIRD CIRCUIT

STANDING ORDER

Investigative, expert, or other services necessary to adequate representation are available to persons who are eligible for representation under the Criminal Justice Act. 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(e). The Third Circuit requires that all requests for service providers for amounts in excess of the case compensation maximums receive prior approval from the Chief Judge of the circuit or his designee. *See* Guide to Judiciary Policy, Vol. 7A, Ch. 3, § 310.20.

In order to facilitate the timely review of requests for service providers for amounts in excess of the case compensation maximums, it is hereby ORDERED that all such requests be submitted via eVoucher. If counsel submits a request by motion, the motion shall be returned to counsel with instructions to resubmit the request via eVoucher. This requirement is effective as of May 1, 2020.
