

**DESIGNATION OF A CIRCUIT JUDGE
FOR SERVICE IN A DISTRICT COURT WITHIN THE CIRCUIT**


WHEREAS, the Honorable Thomas I. Vanaskie, a Circuit Judge for the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, has requested intracircuit assignment to sit in the District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania for the limited purpose of conducting Reentry Court; and

WHEREAS, the Third Circuit Judicial Council has discretion to authorize this assignment; and

WHEREAS, it is the view of the undersigned and the Judicial Council that this special designation is not inconsistent with the rules on intracircuit assignment; and

WHEREAS, this assignment will be at no cost to the Judiciary,

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby designate and assign Judge Vanaskie to sit in the Middle District of Pennsylvania beginning on April 28, 2010, *nunc pro tunc*, and for such additional time thereafter as may be required.
