STANDING ORDER

WHEREAS the court finds that Mary Jane Pelton is enrolled as a student of law at Temple University, Beasley School of Law, engaging in individual research which fulfills the requirements of 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization and that a request from Mary Jane Pelton seeking exemption from payment of fees under the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information,

WHEREAS Mary Jane Pelton is prohibited by this Order from selling for profit any data obtained as a result of this Order in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1914.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT a PACER ID and password be issued to Mary Jane Pelton entrusted with the required research of the aforementioned University for the Advancement of the American Legal System and for specific research in federal courts commencing August 26, 2007 through December 20, 2007.
