In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28 United States Code, Section 631 et seq., the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, the August 29, 2007 Report of the Merit Selection Panel appointed pursuant to Chapter III, Section 3.01 of the Regulations for the Appointment of United States Magistrate Judges, and a majority vote of all active judges of this appointing court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Honorable Thomas M. Blewitt, be and is hereby reappointed full-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary and with official station as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at **12:01 a.m. EST on February 21, 2008**, but prior to the performance of such duties shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28 United States Code, Section 453 and 631(g).

The said full-time United States Magistrate Judge is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight (8) years from the effective date of his appointment, subject to the provisions of Title 28 United States Code, Sections 631(c) and (f).
