
NOW, this 4th ORDER day of December, 1987, as part of the juror fee regulations for the district this court adopts a maximum daily amount of reimbursement for individual juror parking.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk shall not reimburse any juror more than \$7.50 per day for parking regardless of the actual fee incurred.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall regularly monitor the maximum fee being charged by parking facilities at each location for holding court and will report to the Court whenever he determines that the Court should consider a change in this standing order.




