
ORDER

THE BACKGROUND OF THIS ORDER IS AS FOLLOWS:

On October 24, 2008, the court adopted the Court-Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program. C.A.R.E. is a voluntary re-entry program for offenders designed to facilitate the participant's reintegration into the community and maximize the participant's potential for success during the period of supervised release and beyond.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, Magistrate Judge Karoline Mehalchick is appointed as presiding judge for the Scranton Court Assisted Re-Entry (C.A.R.E.) Program. Such appointment shall be for all re-entry court proceedings.
