STANDING ORDER

The Court having been informed that a federal law enforcement agent resident in the

Harrisburg Courthouse has tested positive for COVID-19 and that several other individuals who

were exposed to this agent are exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19, and to ensure to

the extent possible, the health and safety of the public, jurors, grand jurors, court and agency

staff and judicial officers, from further exposure to or spread of the disease;

IT IS ORDERED, that with the concurrence of the judicial officers of the Middle District,

the Facility Security Committee, and GSA, the United States Courthouse in Harrisburg,

Pennsylvania is closed until further notice.

The United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania remains open for

official business, but until further notice all Harrisburg Courthouse proceedings shall be

transferred to either the Williamsport Courthouse or the Scranton Courthouse at the discretion of

the judge to whom the matter is assigned.
