



AND NOW, this 21st day of September 2021, it is hereby ORDERED that the findings and directives of Standing Order 2020-19 are hereby extended for a period of 90 days from the date of this Order based on my finding that emergency conditions continue to exist, the President's emergency declaration remains in effect, and the Judicial Conference's finding that the emergency conditions will materially affect the functioning of the federal courts has not changed. The undersigned will continue to review the authorizations made in Standing Order 2020-19 every ninety days as required by § 15002(b)(3)(B) of the CARES Act.
