## ORDER REAPPOINTING FULL TIME UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Honorable Joseph F. Saporito, Jr. be and is hereby reappointed full-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary and with official station fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.
